

Welcome foreign and French researchers Science Accueil's letter May 2010

Dear Friends, Science Accueil is glad to inform you with its latest news to help you to facilitate your stay.

Short-stay scientific visas are now free!

The Community Code of Visas came into effect on April 4th, 2010. This Code was created to gather in a unique text all the regulations, directives and other European legal texts laying down rules on short-stay visas towards the Schengen area. As regards foreign "scientists", the information of interest is in the article 16 of the Code, 4th paragraph, c):

« 4- Les demandeurs suivants sont exemptés du paiement des droits de visa: (...) c) les chercheurs ressortissants de pays tiers se déplaçant à des fins de recherche scientifique, au sens de la recommandation 2005/761/CE du Parlement européen et du Conseil du 28 septembre 2005 visant à faciliter la délivrance par les États membres de visas uniformes de court séjour pour les chercheurs ressortissants de pays tiers se déplaçant aux fins de recherche scientifique dans la Communauté; »

Henceforth, short-stay visas with the mention "scientist" are thus free for any foreigner requesting for it to the consular service on which (s)he depends. Up to now, a short-stay visa cost 60 Euros.

Freedom of circulation for third countries nationals holding a long-stay visa!

The European Commission thought about the problem of the freedom of circulation of nationals of third countries holding a long-stay visa: These nationals had to wait for the delivery of their residence permit or for the apposition of the stamp from OFII on their VLS TS before being able to move freely within the Schengen area. Because the apposition of the OFII stamp or the delivery of the resident's permit can take several months, there was a talk for legislating at the European level to give these nationals the possibility of travelling freely on the only base of their long-stay visa of current validity.

It is henceforth made since <u>a Regulation dated March 25th</u>, in force since April 5th, allows long-stay visa holders to circulate freely within the Schengen area.

Beware: France again has to modify the mentions affixed on the long-stay visas, because it may be still indicated "valid for: France + 1 transit Schengen ", while it should henceforth be " valid for: F + Schengen states.

If a purely material modification of a mention on a visa would not contradict a European law, and if it is thus certain that any foreigner holding a long stay visa can freely circulate with his(her) valid long stay visa while waiting for his(her) resident's permit, it is advisable to be extremely watchful as for the application of this novelty, because you never can tell if the information was passed on well and truly to the Police on the borders and on the police authorities of each country of the Schengen area.
